Work Conditioning

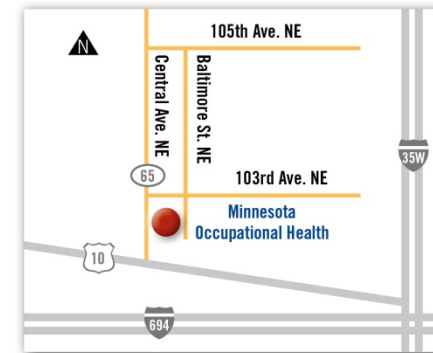

Onsite Drug & Alcohol Collection Services

MOH employs trained and certified professionals who respond to scheduled (random) drug testing events and to short-notice (reasonable suspicion or post-accident) collections.

Drug and alcohol testing can be performed for non-regulated and federal (DOT, FAA, USCG, Pipeline, FRA, FTA, etc.) collections.

Work Injury Experts

All three MOH clinics provide walk-in urgent care for nearly all work injuries. MOH occupational or emergency medicine specialists are committed to helping workers remain as mobile and active as is safely possible following an injury.



Employers who bring injured workers into the clinic can be included in the conversation between the patient and the MOH Provider when discussing recovery and light duty restrictions. MOH works closely with claims managers and QRC's when their involvement is required.

Work Injury Status Reports are sent electronically to the employer. Notes and transcriptions are automatically sent to the claims manager and insurer.

Two full-time Workers' Compensation Specialists coordinate approvals, referrals and scheduling within the MOH / Summit Orthopedics preferred provider network for advanced imaging, therapy and surgery.
